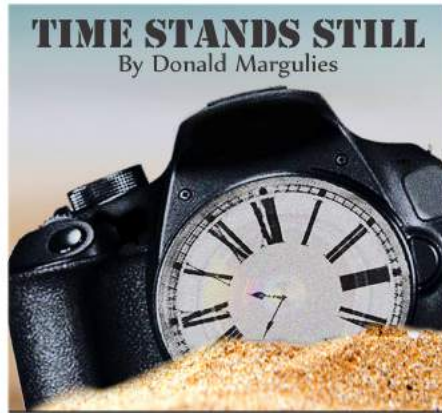

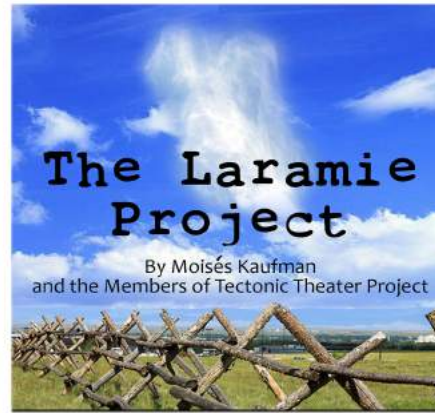

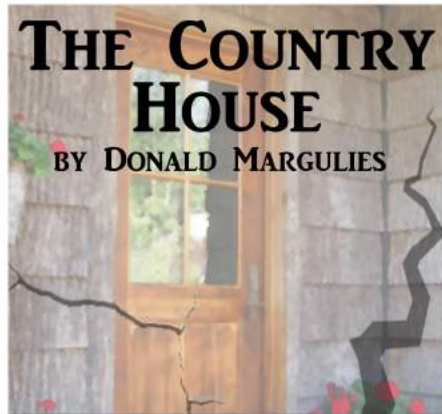


**MAR 24 - APR 15, 2017**

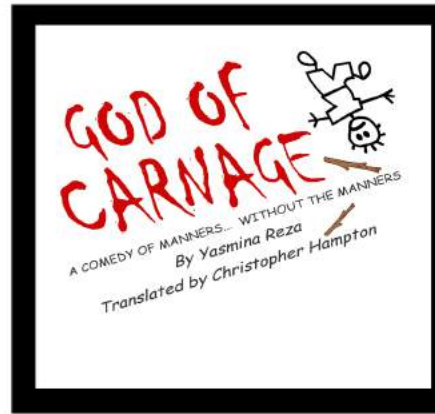
